PLEASE PROTECT HĀ'ENA STATE PARK

(Hā'ena State Park includes: the Kalalau Trail/Hanakāpi'ai Falls/Kē'ē Beach)

To protect cultural and natural resources from overuse, Hā'ena State Park is now subject to daily visitor limits and requires advanced reservations to enter the park. Please observe the following practices:

▶ **PLEASE AVOID DRIVING TO HĀ'ENA STATE PARK WITHOUT AN ADVANCE RESERVATION AND PERMIT.** Vehicles without a reservation and permit will be kindly asked to turn around. Please visit <https://www.go-haena.com/> for more information, and note that there is no cellular reception at Hā'ena State Park, so reservations must be made in advance.

- Parking at Hā'ena State Park is extremely limited, and requires advance reservations and a permit.
- Presently no overnight parking is allowed at the Hā'ena State Park parking lot.
- Walk-ins also require a permit reserved in advance of your visit.

▶ **PLEASE USE THE NORTH SHORE SHUTTLE.** Your reservation ticket to Hā'ena State Park includes your paid entrance to the park and helps diminish impacts on this natural and culturally sensitive area, so future generations may experience it. Please visit <https://kauainsshuttle.com/> to reserve your seat.

▶ **THERE IS NO PARKING ALONG KŪHIŌ HIGHWAY IN HĀ'ENA.** Illegally parking along the Kūhiō Highway interferes with local traffic and creates health and economic hazards for residents and visitors alike. Fines and surcharges for illegal parking may be up to \$400.00.

▶ **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON SIDE STREETS** in Hā'ena to respect residents who call these neighborhoods home.

▶ Road and bridge construction continues on Kūhiō Highway. For road conditions and closures, please go to <https://hidot.hawaii.gov/highways/roadwork/kaui/>

▶ Kūhiō Highway on the North Shore is a narrow highway with one-lane bridges, so we ask drivers to show aloha and yield to oncoming cars at one-lane bridges. Please learn about the Hanalei to Hā'ena road code of conduct at www.alohapledge.com/5/hanalei-to-haena-road-code-of-conduct.
